

Except for our rolling diaphragm 1X type parts, all Airmount[®] isolators and Airstroke[®] actuators are available with bead rings for those applications where bead plates are not suitable. Typical examples where bead rings are often used would be as follows:

1. Where parts are stacked to increase stroke.
2. Where parts are being used as a boot or flexible connector.
3. When used as an Airmount isolator with an auxiliary reservoir.
4. When air, or other media, must move in or out of the unit at an extremely fast rate.
5. When used with an internal shaft, to either guide the part or the pull rather than push a load.

When using bead rings, the customer will need to fabricate his own mounting plates. Hot or cold rolled steel provides satisfactory mounting surfaces, with specific finishes of 250 micro inches, if machined in a circular fashion, and 32 micro inches when ground. Since the rubber part provides its own seal, "O" rings are not needed when installing the part. On page 2 is a chart listing the type of bead ring, bolt circle diameter and number of bolts required per ring for each style Airmount-Airstroke airspring. On page three is a cross-sectional view of the different style rings and bolts.

The ribbed neck bead ring is also available in an unequal bolt hole spacing pattern. The sale of this ring should be limited to replacement parts only and not sold for new applications.

Stainless Steel Bead Rings

When using bead rings, the customer will have to fabricate his own mounting plates. Stainless steel plates with the surface finishes described above should be used. Page 4 lists the different styles that have stainless bead rings available.

Firestone does not furnish stainless steel bolts, these will need to be supplied by the customer.

WARNING: Do not allow the threaded end of the bolt to extend beyond the bottom surface of the bead ring, damage to the rubber bellows will result and could cause premature failure.

Tighten all bolts one(1) turn each time in a "Star" pattern around the bolt circle, until continuous contact is made between the bead ring and the mounting plate.

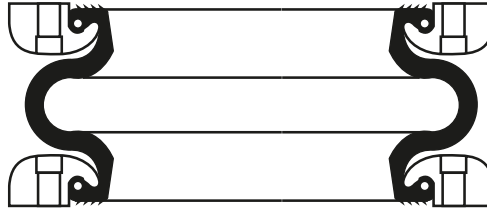
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Bead Rings Cross Sectional Views

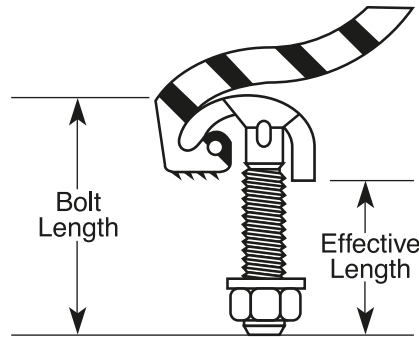

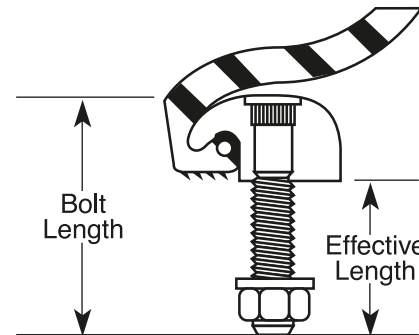
